As HRDC approaches its 54th anniversary, we look back at what we have accomplished, and, forward to the work that remains. In the last half century, HRDC has served tens of thousands of people over the five county service area as it helped to build communities. You may not be aware that HRDC is one of over 1000 community action agencies that cover 99 percent of all counties in the United States.

More often than not, when individuals and families come to HRDC for help they are in a crisis. They have lost a job, a sick family member, need assistance with housing, food, a utility bill, broken down vehicle, childcare, and a myriad of other challenges. While individuals and families often focus on the crisis, we thought you might like to see some of the agency's happy-endings. Here are a few vignettes from folks that HRDC have been able to help in many different ways through diverse programs and services.

You may not know that HRDC administers 23 programs not including, events and special projects, such as Playdate at the Zoo, Suited for Success, or the Housing Navigator Project. Many of the agency's services also target moderate-income community members including VITA, a no cost state and federal income tax preparation service for all folks making less than \$55,000. The Home Center provides individualized financial counseling, saving programs, first time homebuyers courses, and much more.

My job interview went well, and I even received a compliment on how great I looked during the interview. I can't thank you enough for the opportunity HRDC provided. -Chris




## Some Happy Endings From The Last Year


