Recent updates and expanded eligibility for Best Beginnings Child Care Scholarships



\$10 per month co-pay per scholarship family*

- To support families in meeting their co-payment obligations, all the Best Beginnings families will see their co-pays set to \$10 per month.



Scholarships cover full authorized amounts regardless of attendance*

- To support families and the various scheduling needs that may arise, the Best Beginnings Scholarship will cover the full amount of scheduled care regardless of attendance.



Updated sliding fee scale now expands eligibility to more Montana Families*

- Income eligibility has been increased to serve additional families.

For example: a family of 4 making \$4,085 or less per month may be eligible for child care assistance.

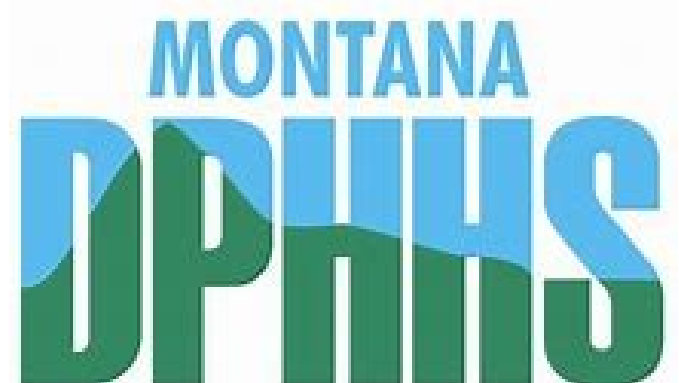
