Billings Point in Time Count 2024

The Point in Time (PIT) Homeless Count took place on January 25th across the nation. In Billings, 30 volunteers were dispersed throughout the city to survey individuals currently facing homelessness. A couple noteworthy volunteers included Billings Mayor Bill Cole and his wife Anne.

Before the count officially began, all volunteers met at the HRDC parking lot to go over safety procedures. 75 bags were passed out to give to individuals who took the survey. Inside the HRDC logoed bags were snacks, hygiene kits, socks and hand warmers.

This event was a community effort we are proud to do alongside the Yellowstone County Continuum of Care. A total 220 hard copy surveys received were put into the online database for the national count.

The US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) leads the count to see how many Americans are currently experiencing homelessness.

Last year, there were 2,178 homeless persons in the state of Montana. Official data collected from the count will be available later this year.
